Illness and Attendance

We are aware that there are a number of viruses and illnesses going around. We urge any parent who is worried about illness to consult the NHS website to get advice about how to treat their child and whether or not their child should be in school. Vomiting and diarrhea requires children to be off school for 48 hours. We know parents know best when to keep children off.

Unfortunately we can't give Calpol in school, but parents/carers are welcome to come to school to administer Calpol if they want their children to have it. We can administer antibiotics in school, only if they need to be taken 4 times a day. 3 doses times a day can be managed at home.
