Afterschool Clubs

Afterschool club selection for KS1&KS2 were sent yesterday and deadline was **today by 12pm** so that club confirmations can be sent before clubs start Tuesday afterschool.

There will be **8 sessions** in this term and the cost of each session is **£1.50**. If your child is given a **Monday club** there will be **7 sessions** for this as it is **BH Monday on 4th May** and we will not be in school.

There will be no Pupil Premium discount for any clubs. We try to keep the cost as fair as possible for all our families and have kept the price per session to **£1.50**.

All clubs finish at **4pm**, except from the sports clubs finishing at **4:15pm**.

You will sent confirmation **Monday 4th May** via ping of what club(s) your child has received and then all payments will be on ParentPay.

Clubs will start **W/B Monday 4th May** (but no clubs Mon 4th as this is Bank Holiday) and will go up to **W/B Monday 6th July**. Last day of Clubs will be **Friday 10th July**.

A reminder that SATs week begins on **Monday 11th May**. It is very important that all children arrive on time each day.
