📦 Uniform Reminder

Thank you for your continued support in ensuring that our children come to school looking smart and ready to learn.

A few reminders regarding our school uniform:

- Trainers and boots should not be worn as school shoes.
- Our summer uniform may continue to be worn until after the October half-term holiday.
- Jewellery is not permitted, with the exception of a simple watch and small stud earrings.
- Earrings must NOT be worn on PE days as children cannot participate in PE wearing earrings.
- Hair accessories should be in school colours and should be simple and appropriate for school.

Playground Supervision

A gentle reminder that children must remain supervised on the school playground until their teacher arrives.

Parents and carers are asked to remain with their children until the class teacher comes out to collect them.

Once the teacher has arrived, children will then enter school with their class.

Can all our parents and families please be mindful at drop off and pick up that we aren't blocking roads, parking on double yellows or parking on the pavements. We value our children's and families safety and need to make sure we are following all safety guidelines.

Mobile Phones and Smartwatches – Important Reminder

Our updated Mobile Devices Policy has now come into force.

Wherever possible, children should not bring mobile phones into school.

We recognise that some children in Years 5 and 6 may need to bring a phone with them if they are walking home independently. In these circumstances:

- The phone must be switched off before the child enters the school grounds.
- It must then be handed to the class teacher, who will securely lock it away during the school day.
- The phone will remain switched off and securely stored until the end of the school day.

It must not be switched back on until the child has left the school grounds.

Similarly, smartwatches should not be worn in school wherever possible. If a smartwatch is considered necessary, it must also be handed to the teacher and securely stored for the duration of the school day.

These arrangements are in place to support children's safety, wellbeing, privacy and their ability to focus fully on learning.

Medication and Inhalers

Please remember that if your child requires medication, an inhaler, an epi pen or any other prescribed medication in school, this must be brought into the school office and recorded appropriately.

Please ensure that:

- Medication is in date and clearly labelled with your child's name.
- The school is informed of any changes to your child's medication or medical needs.
- Inhalers and other essential medication are kept up to date and replaced promptly when they expire or are used.

Parents/carers inform the school office if a medication or healthcare plan needs to be reviewed.

It is particularly important that we have the correct medication available at all times for children who may need it during the school day.
