A reminder to parents that all PE kits (including an outdoor pair of shoes and their correct house team t-shirt) must be kept in school all week.

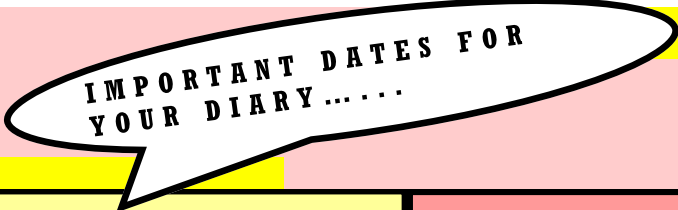
